

#### About Our Keynote Speaker

Dr. David J. Bearss is the founder and CEO of Halia Therapeutics. He is a seasoned entrepreneur and drug developer with over 20 years of experience in academic and industry settings. He possesses expertise in small molecule drug development utilizing usture-based drug design and computational approaches for drug discovery. He focuses on translational research in drug development and genetic markers to predict drug sensitivity. Dr. Bearss has discovered 16 compounds with accepted INDs by the FBA and ha worked on two approved drugs. Dr. Bearss has cofounded eight biotech companies and is an inventor with over 75 patents and an author with 85 previewed research publications. He has won several awards for his entrepreneurial and scientific efforts hand recently been awarded the Utah Governors Medal of Science.

#### Historical Overview of Roseman University of Health Sciences

Roseman University of Health Sciences began as the Nevada College of Pharmacy, an idea from one man, Dr. Harry Rosenberg. Dr. RosenbergÕs idea was that pharmacy education should be and could be better, more effective, and capable of producing highly comptetraduates, who would be soughter by employers regardless of the job market. His belief in this idea was so strong that he moved from California in August 1999, and with \$15,000, dhied of which was his own, rented a 900 square foot office in the PainterÕs Union Building on Whitney Mesa Avenue in Henderson to begin the planning and development of what was to become one of the most innovative, creative, aneffective Colleges of Pharmacy in the nation.

The inaugural class of the Nevada College of Pharmacy was recruited in the fall of 2000 and those 38

universityÕs mission as Òa leader in transforming health care education.Ó The name became effective on July 1, 2011.

In 2013, the University completed a merger with the Nevada Cancer Institute Foundation, securing the 184,000 square foot Engelstad Cancer Research Building to bolster its medical research programs. In April 2014, the University purchased the adjacent **043**square foot Flagship Building of the former Nevada Cancer Institute. Combined, the two buildings make up what is now Roseman UniversityÕs Summerlin campus, home to the UniversityÕs College of Medicine, which was approved for development by the Board of Trustees in December 2013. The College of Medicine is currently in development and will pursue accreditation with the Liaison Committee on Medical Education, the accrediting body for medical schools in the U.S. and Canada.

In June 2018, Roseman University and Cure 4 The Kids Foundation formally agreed to a partnership to create a onef-a-kind collaboration in the State of Nevada with Cure 4 The Kids becoming an independent division of Roseman University of Health Sciemcesneved its administrative and clinical

THE CAPThe academic cap is usually black the material matches the gown. Mortar boards are generally recommended. The color of the tassel denotes the discipline.

THE HOOD-The most colorful and distinctive item of the academic costume is the hood which passes around the neck and extends down the back. The doctorÕs hood is the largest of the hoods and the bachelorÕs is the smallest. The bachelorÕs hood is **diften o**The color of velvet edging indicates the field of learning. The hood is lined with the official color of the college/university. The color of the facing denotes the discipline represented by the degree. Colors associated with different degree; Business, drab; Dentistry, lilac; Economics, copper; Education, light blue; Engineering, orange; Fine Arts, brown; Hospital Administration, salmon; Journalism, crimson; Law, purple; Medicine, green; Music, pink; Nursing, apricot; Pharmacyljvæ green; Philosophy, dark blue; Public Administration, peacock blue; Science, golden yellow; Social Service, citron; and Theology, scarlet.

PERMISSIBLE EXCEPTIONS may members of the governing body of a college or university, whatever their degrees, are entitled to wear doctor's gowns (with black velvet), but their hoods may be only those of degrees actually held by the wearers or those **alspec** is cribed for them by the institution. The chief marshal may wear a specially designed costume approved by the institution.

### The Mace

The mace is identified with the Office of the President and is carried in academic processions at commencement and convocation ceremonies. Historical maces date back to the total by when they were first carried as ceremonial symbols of royal authority at events attended by English Kings. The PresidentÕs medallion is in the form of the University Seal and is made of solid sterling silver and held by a ribbon representing the University colors of burgundy and silver. The medallion represents the authority of the President as the higheshidiagy in the institution.


